## **Irrigation Update**

Reminder that SBFE 2-week irrigation cycle is ending October 25<sup>th</sup>. Irrigation will move into a 3-week irrigation cycle and is scheduled to begin on Wednesday, November 9<sup>th</sup> and irrigation service will start on Cactus.

Fall is here and so are the leaves. Please ensure that you are keeping your lots clear of tall grass, weeds, and leaves to prevent irrigation water overflow and that your irrigation flows on your lot without buildup of debris.

Lots that have tall grass and weeds over 6 inches or visible gopher holes where irrigation water is draining into the street will be placed on cut-off and a door hanger left advising why the lot could not be irrigated or that the lot needs berm repair, etc.

## **Bulk Trash**

Since Bulk trash has been delayed, please use this time to clear your lot and back areas on the Bridle Path. Many lots still have overgrown grass, weeds, tumble weeds that are higher than 12" and protruding into the Bridle paths. Low over hanging branches are causing issues with lot owners (your neighbors) getting to and from their back lots, in addition this is a safety concern should there be a need for first responders to get to a back lot to take care of an emergency. Take a walk and look at the back of your bridle path area and be a good neighbor and clear your areas. If you need a referral for a landscaper, please contact admin@sbfehome.com.
